IN MEMORIAM PROFESSOR JAN BÍLEK

Professor RNDr. Jan Bílek, Head of the Department of Mathematics of the Institute of Chemical Technology and Dean of the Faculty of Chemical Engineering, died in Prague on March 10, 1972.

Prof. JAN BÍLEK was born on May 15, 1907 in Žďár near Mnichovo Hradiště. After graduating from the university he was teacher at a secondary school. In the year 1946 he joined the Institute of Chemical Technology, remaining member of its staff till his death. It was this Institute where he was appointed Associated Professor (Dozent) in 1952 and Professor in 1959. In the years 1953—6 as well as since 1966 till the end of his life he was Dean of the Faculty of Chemical Engineering.

The main field of scientific interest of Prof. Bílek was the algebraic geometry. As a pupil of Prof. B. Bydžovský he made his start in the classical algebraic geometry, but soon he got engaged fully in modern disciplines which are characterized by making use of abstract algebra and topology. His scientific work was closely connected with his educational activity. He was a co-author of a textbook of mathematics for secondary schools and of a number of university lecture notes. At the same time, he contributed considerably to the activities of the Union of Czechoslovak Mathematicians and Physicists.
