FOREWORD

The 15th Winter School "Geometry and Physics" was organized at the usual place, the village Srni in Czech Republic, in the period January 14 - January 21, 1995. During the school, six invited lectures series were presented by Toby Bailey, Vladimir Dobrev, Michael Eastwood, Stefan Jackowski, Victor Kac and Lionel Mason, three or four lectures each. In the remaining program, 49 further lectures, communications and posters were presented in two sections.
