PREFACE

These Proceedings contain the lectures presented at the Spring School

"Nonlinear Analysis, Function Spaces and Applications"

held on May 21-26, 1978 in Horní Bradlo (Eastern Bohemia) and organized by the Mathematical Institute of the Czechoslovak Academy of Sciences, by the Faculty of Mathematics and Physics of Charles University, Prague, and by the Technical University, Plzeň (Pilsen).

This school was the sixth in a series of conferences organized periodically and alternately in Czechoslovakia (1971, 1974) and the German Democratic Republic (1972, 1975, 1977) under the cooperation of the Mathematical Institutes of the Academies of Sciences of the both countries.

Unlike the above mentioned conferences where the short communications prevailed, the organizers of the last school decided to make survey lectures the center of the session. Nine of them were delivered, while the short communications were presented in a written form. As a manuscript of one of the main lectures has not reached the editors, the present volume contains eight contributions. A list of short communications is included at the end of the volume, as well as a list of participants, the total number of which was 79 from the following countries: Belgium (1), Federal Republic of Germany (5), France (1), German Democratic Republic (14), Italy (5), Poland (2), Soviet Union (1), United Kingdom (1), Czechoslovakia (49).

The credit for the organisation of the school goes mainly to Dr. Miroslav KRBEČ, Dr. Jiří RÁKOSNÍK and Dr. Jiří HOLENDÁ; Mrs. Eva FIEDLEROVÁ took care of the participants at the place of the conference. She also typed the text of these Proceedings, while Dr. Jiří JARNÍK prepared its English version. We should like to thank all of them. Thanks are due to the staff of the Publishing House TEUBNER, Leipzig (GDR) for the prompt publication of these Proceedings.
