IN MEMORIAM PROFESSOR RNDR. JOSEF BÍLÝ, CSC.

On October 4, 1970, an outstanding specialist in mathematical statistics and mathematical economy Prof. RNDr. Josef Bílíy, CSc., died at the age of 65.

The scope of activities of Professor Bílý was diverse and manysided. He gave courses and postgradual lectures in insurance mathematics, mathematical statistics, econometry as well as numerical mathematics. He took a considerable part in the establishment of economical studies at the Faculty of Mathematics and Physics of the Charles University as well as in creating the Centre of Numerical Mathematics at the Faculty.

The death of Professor Bílý has meant a severe loss for a great number of research workers both in theoretical and applied research in economical-mathematical methods. They have lost a kind friend and an invaluable counsellor and leader who always succeeded in inspiring the right direction of their work. For all those who knew him, he has been a paragon not only of an excellent scientist, but also of a man of honour and high moral principles.
